Aktivita FCE I.

Škola: Gymnázium Bystřice nad Pernštejnem

Název aktivity: Speaking

Předmět: Konverzace anglického jazyka

Ročník, třída: septima, 3.A

Jazyk a jazyková úroveň žáků: angličtina – B1 +

Datum realizace: 19. 2. 2018

Forma realizace: skupinová, ve dvojicích

Stručný popis aktivity: Speaking part – FCE zkoušky

Použité metody: diskuse, porovnávání obrázků, řešení problémů

Použité pomůcky: pracovní list

Časová náročnost: 30 min

Postup realizace: Studenty rozdělíme do dvou skupin (A, B). Každá skupina má sadu otázek týkajících se tématu Vánoce. Každý student si vybere otázky, které bude pokládat svým kolegům (2,5 minuty). Poté si vymění role a student (2,5 minuty). Po ukončení se učitel zeptá studentů na některé otázky a ostatní budou moci vyjádřit svůj názor přede všemi (5 minut).

Studenti budou pracovat ve dvojicích a porovnávat obrázky (1 minuta) a reagovat na otázku, která se týká partnerových obrázků (0,5 minuty). Poté si role vymění. Studenti budou poslouchat a zaznamenají si případné nedostatky, které brání porozumění, gramatické chyby, ale i co se jim líbilo. Po skončení dají svým spolužákům feedback (1-2 minuty).

Studenti budou ve dvojicích diskutovat o vhodném dárku pro svého učitele (2 minuty) a výsledkem této aktivity bude vybrat ten nejvhodnější dárek (1 minuta). Každá dvojice pak svým spolužákům sdělí, jaký dárek vybrali a proč (6 minut).

Poslední aktivitou mluvené části zkoušky, je vyjádření názoru, reakce, atd. Studenti si navzájem budou klást otázky a odpovídat a ně (4 minuty).
