Použité pomůcky: pracovní list, video (youtube.com), poslech

Časová náročnost: 45 min

Postup realizace: Na úvod hodiny se studenti budou v malých skupinách bavit o jejich oblíbených televizních seriálech (cca 5 minut). Poté napíšeme na tabuli jejich oblíbené seriály. Zeptáme se na známé anglické seriály, abychom získali seriály jako je Mr Bean nebo Doctor Who. Zopakujeme si, jaké minulé časy studenti znají, jejich formu a použití – napíšeme si příkladové věty na tabuli. Studenty rozdělíme do dvojic nebo malých skupin. Každý student má svůj pracovní list. Studenti budou spojovat věty podle instrukcí (změna slovesného času, přidání spojek) a utvoří souvětí. Studenti musí přemýšlet o sledu dějů, které později uvidí v krátkém videu. Poté si přečteme věty studentů a následně se podíváme na video a budeme si postupně opravovat věty. Poté budou studenti pracovat na pracovním listu a doplní do textu správný tvar sloves v závorce. Následně si poslechneme ukázkou a zkontrolujeme.
